SHARE IT! (INGOL AND TANTERTON) FOODBANK

Our local SVP (St Vincent de Paul) group is working in partnership with Share IT! foodbank. Do you know of anyone in emergency need of food? Maybe someone recently registered for Universal Credit who is waiting for their first payment? The Share IT! foodbank is open on Tuesdays 10.00 am-11.00 am and 1.00 pm-2.00 pm, Wednesdays 2.00 pm-3.00 pm, Thursdays 10.00 am-11.00 am and Saturdays 10.00 am-11.00 am. The foodbank can be found at Holy Family Pastoral Centre, which is on the corner of Redcar Ave and Whitby Ave, PR2 3YP. Look for the green sign! For enquiries telephone 07545 277779. The foodbank operates using a referral system via Agencies, and as such OLCHS can issue vouchers to families who are in need. In cases of emergency people can self-refer to the foodbank without a voucher and will just be asked for a few details. In exceptional circumstances e.g. if a family is isolating and has no other source of help, via the SVP we can do a "knock and drop" service to deliver food and household basics. Any contact with the foodbank or the SVP will be in the strictest confidence.
