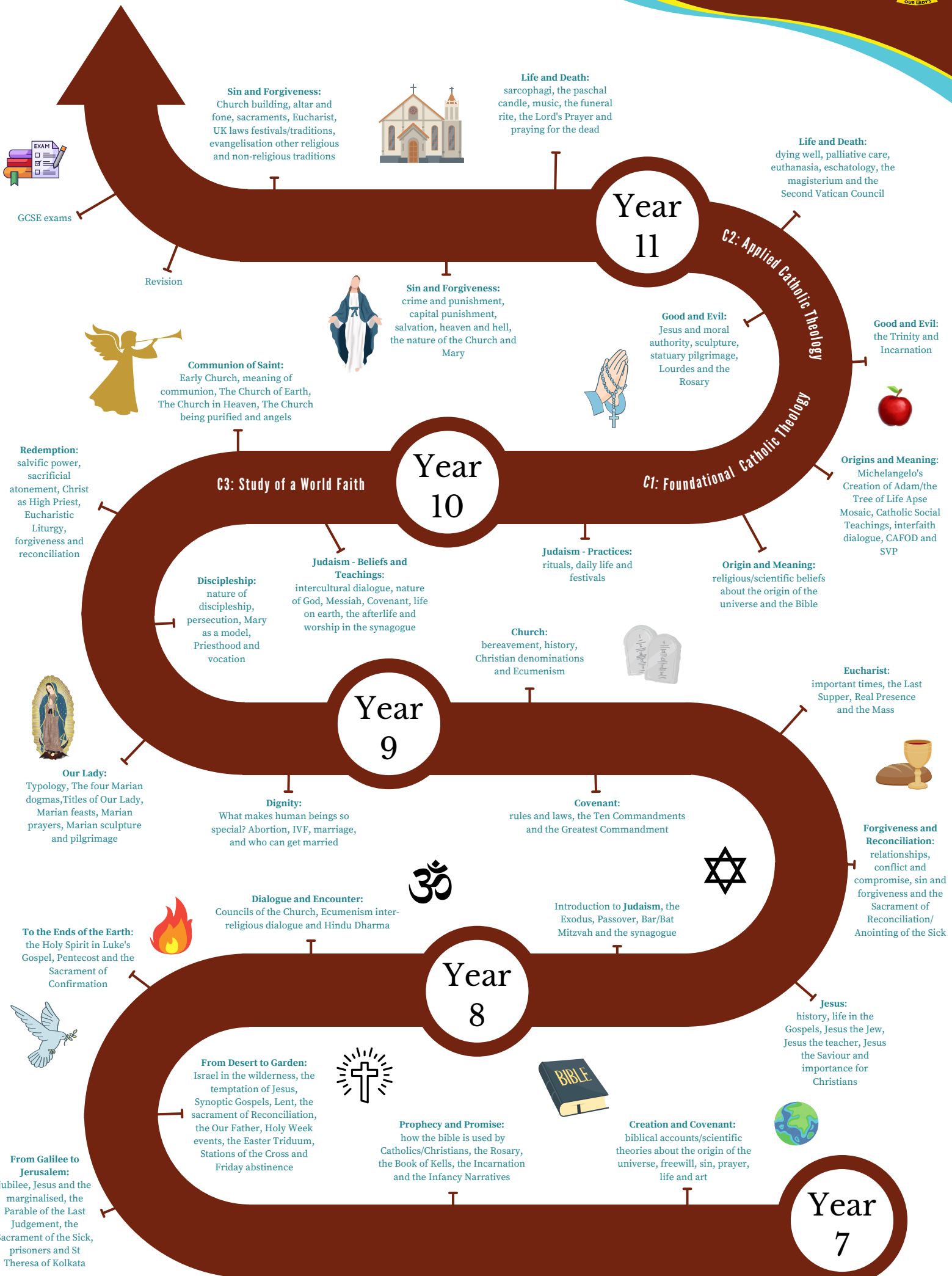


What will I learn in RE?
